Here are some basic rules about clubs:

1. Though clubs must be led by students, all clubs have to have a staff advisor
2. Clubs MUST re-enroll EVERY year by re-submitting a club form (on the reverse) to the Boone Center/Library BEFORE they can meet
3. New Clubs must have administrator approval BEFORE they can meet
4. No clubs can discriminate in membership (gender, religion, politics, etc.)
5. Any fundraising done by clubs must be approved at least a month beforehand; there's a fundraising form available in the library.
6. Student officers are optional, but there must be at least one student responsible for signing club paperwork
